This curriculum is designed to be worked through in eight weeks. It is designed to first address the “Foundation Issues” and then give you “Application Points.”

Over the years of working with individuals who need financial restoration, we have noticed one key ingredient in successful clients: **Desperation**. If you are truly desperate for change, you will **hear and apply** the principles taught in this class. If you are not desperate, you will simply hear a good teaching, but not experience true, lasting change.

What Are You Committing To?

This class is best used in a small-group setting. We believe that true, lasting change will come as you experience life-changing truth and apply it in the context of a strong, accountable community. **Therefore we expect 3 things from you:**

1. Each week, please be early for each class and be open and engaged in discussion.
2. Find one person (other than your spouse) to be accountable with about your finances during and after this class.
3. Prior to each week: 1) Accomplish all homework assignments, 2) and, memorize the *Key Verse* for the previous lesson.

Decide now to not just hear good information, but to *apply* it. Decide now to take the next two months and clear out the noise of life and fix your financial foundation. You will not regret it!
